DATE OF ADMISSION: August 1, 2007

PATIENT IDENTIFICATION: Mr. Silcox is an 84-year-old gentleman who lives at Caressant Care

REASON FOR ADMISSION: Right surgical neck femur fracture

HISTORY OF PRESENTING ILLNESS: Mr. Silcox lives in Caressant Care Nursing Home. He fell yesterday onto his right side. The patient has Alzheimer's so he cannot give a good history. He is not complaining of any pain unless he moves his right leg. He did not sustain any head trauma and did not have any loss of consciousness. He was sent in from the nursing home for an x-ray due to this fall.

PAST MEDICAL HISTORY: Hypothyroid, Insulin dependent diabetes, Alzheimer's, diverticulitis.

MEDICATIONS: Metformin 500 mg po bid, Synthroid 0.15 mg po od, Exelon 3 mg po bid, Plavix 75 mg po od, Lipitor 20 mg po q supper, Pantoloc 40 mg po od, Trazodone 25 mg po qhs, Insulin which is 30/70 25 units AC breakfast and 13 units AC supper.

PAST SURGICAL HISTORY: Traumatic amputation of his fingers in 1949 and 1980, hemorrhoidectomy 1962, appendectomy 1967, fracture of right ankle 1995, laparoscopic cholecystectomy in 1994, cataract extraction x2 in 1999, percutaneous insertion of drainage tube in the right flank April 2006 and I&D of an abdominal abscess August 2006.

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION: On exam Mr. Silcox's vitals were as follows; Blood pressure 125/79, pulse 88 and regular, resp. 20, O2 saturation 94% on room air and temperature 37.0. The patient is not in any distress. The right hip exam shows that he has his leg externally rotated. Cap refill is approximately 2 seconds and he has normal sensation. He is not able to move the leg due to pain. X-ray shows that he has a surgical neck fracture of his right femur.

ASSESSMENT AND PLAN: Mr. Silcox has suffered a right femur fracture. We will admit him under Dr. Kocsis, the family doctor, with a consult into the orthopedic surgeon on-call tomorrow. We will give him Fragmin in preparation for prophylaxis. We will also give him good pain control and make him comfortable.
